

## General Guidelines



1. Candidates are required to read the prospectus carefully before filling the application form for admission to the B.Ed./D.El.Ed. course in Mathura Singh Teacher Training College. The prospectus provides general information and is subject to the provision of the act of Jai Prakash University, Chapra and BSEB, Patna.
- 2.(a) All seats of B.Ed. course will be filled by combined Entrance Exam conducted by Nodal University.  
(b) All seats of D.El.Ed. course will be filled on the basis of Entrance Exam conducted by BSEB, Patna
3. Students admitted shall be subject to the provision of the act, statutes, ordinances and regulations of Jai Prakash University, Chapra and BSEB, Patna.
4. No candidate shall be entitled to claim admission as a matter of right.



# Course Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) D.El.Ed

- To be admitted to the course for the degree of Bachelor of Education, candidate must have passed the Bachelor of Arts / Science / Commerce examination from any recognized Indian University.
- As per N.C.T.E. Norms, a candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in the aggregate at the Bachelor's Degree / Master Degree Examination from a recognized university.
- Bachelor's in engineering or technology which specialization in science & Mathematics with 55% marks are eligible to apply. However B.B.A. or B.C.A. are not eligible. It is not sufficient for a candidate to have appeared at the degree examination and be awaiting results. He/She must already be in possession of the degree and the Marksheet. Those taking any other course simultaneously with B.Ed. Course are not eligible. Admission be granted on the basis of an Entrance Test.

## Age limit :

For Admission in D.El.Ed. Course minimum age is 17 years on 1st January of the admission year.



## Duration of Course :

The course is of two academic years duration, starting from July each year.

## Intake :

Only 100 students in the college will be admitted in one academic year.

## Medium of Instruction :

The medium of instruction will be Hindi / English. In examination it may be written either in Hindi or in English excluding language subjects.

## D.El.Ed. :

- to be admitted to the course for the diploma in elementary education. Candidate must have passed the intermediate (10+2) exam or equivalent.
- As per NCTE norms a candidate should have secured at least 50% marks (Gen & OBC) and 45% marks (SC/ST) in the aggregate at the intermediate (10+2).



# Rules and Regulations



1. A student admitted to B.Ed./D.El. Ed. course must maintain an ethos of commitment professional programme. He / She is expected to behave in a dignified manner in the college campus.
2.
  - a. The minimum attendance of student-teachers shall have to be 80% for al course work and practicum and 90% for school internship.
  - b. The trainees must attend all demonstration classes during the course as well as his/her scheduled practice teaching classes during January! February. He/She is expected to teach in any school assigned to him / her by the college.
  - c. There shall be at least two hundred working days each year exclusive of the period of examination and admission.
  - d. The institution shall work for a minimum of thirty six hours in a week (five or six days) during which physical presence of student-teachers is necessary.
3. Prior permission is required from the Principal / Professor-in-charge for any absence either from theory or practical classes and community life activities. Application for leave should be given in written form.
4. No other commitments, such as competitive examination, computer course, private tuition. university examination should be undertaken during the regular course timings of classes and activities.
5. Every student is expected to make the best use of library books.
6. The trainees are expected to take proper care of college property.
7. If a candidate wants to drop out from the course before the commencement of classes, he /she will receive refund of fee except admission fee. After commencement of classes there will be no refund of money against the fee deposited at the time of admission.



## Course Completion Requirement for appearing at the University/Board Examination


1. Every candidate of the B.Ed./D.El.Ed. Examination shall produce a certificate from the Principal for the purpose of
  - a. Good conduct
  - b. Having satisfactory completed the work at the college.
2. Candidates, who fail to fulfil the requirement in respect of sessional work or percentage of attendance at lectures, shall not be allowed to appear at the University/Board Examination.



# Documents to be Submitted/Produced at the time of Admission

Admission form is attached along with prospectus. Candidates are required to submit it within scheduled period. If admission form is submitted after over of the last date of admission then it will be rejected. The following documents have to be enclosed with the Admission Form :-

1. Original money receipt.
2. Attested photostat copies of the following certificates :-
  - a. Proof of residency domicile certificate of Bihar state.
  - b. Passport Size photograph 5 pcs.
  - c. Matriculation Certificate for age proof.
  - d. All Certification and marks sheets from matriculation to post graduation level.
  - e. CLC/DLC, Registration Certificate/Migration Certificate (if required).
  - f. Admit Card of last Exam.
  - g. Caste Certificate for SC/ST/OBC candidates (if applicable).
  - h. ID Proof Aadhar Card, PAN Card.
  - i. Fitness Certificate by CMO/CMS.
  - j. Separate application (in plane paper) for Hostel facility (if required).
  - k. Admission Letter provided by University.
  - l. Entrance Admit Card.
